

# Domino

## Contents

60 three-dimensional playing pieces for 2 - 4 players  
2 players - 20 playing pieces  
3 players - 14 playing pieces  
4 players - 10 playing pieces  
1 box with compartments laid out on a grid system

## Preparation (Spielvorbereitung)

Take the corresponding number of playing pieces from the box.  
Put these in front of you and keep the coloured pieces only visible to yourself.

## How to play (Spielablauf)

First of all take 2 playing pieces you like from the box and lay these on the table. Put the 2 pieces with the sloping side together.  
From your own playing pieces take the right positive or negative piece to lay down next to one of the 2 pieces on the table. In the DOMINO game the colour does not make any difference. Then lay one playing piece of your choice next to the sloping side.  
If you have not the right positive or negative piece, take one out of the box and put it to your pieces in front of you. Then it is the next players turn.  
You can change the direction of the line by turning the pieces of 90° up to 4 times.

## Aim of the game (Spielziel)

The player who first has no pieces left is the winner.

# Memo

## Contents

60 three-dimensional playing pieces for 2 - 4 players  
1 box with compartments laid out on a grid system

## Preparation (Spielvorbereitung)

All playing pieces are in the box with the coloured side downwards.  
You can play with less than the 60 playing pieces but an even number of pieces is necessary.

## How to play (Spielablauf)

First of all take 2 playing pieces from the box and make them visible to everybody.  
If you have the right positive and negative piece which belong together and made of the same colour, than take the 2 playing pieces with you. Then you take another 2 playing pieces from the box.  
If the 2 playing pieces do not belong together put them back in the box in the same position.  
Then it is the next players turn.

## Aim of the game (Spielziel)

The game ends as soon as all pieces are taken from the box.  
The player with the most playing pieces is the winner.
